

As we prepare to celebrate the 200th anniversary of Chi Phi's founding, we should rejoice in the rich heritage that has carried us through the many ups and downs in our nation's history. We should take pride in our extraordinary Brotherhood, our historic accomplishments, and the lifelong bonds that we have fostered. And we should ask ourselves: what is it going to take to ensure Chi Phi continues to thrive for the next two centuries and beyond?



A GREEK LIFE REVIVAL

Contrary to headlines, the Greek system is experiencing a resurgence in interest. During the 2022–2023 academic year, more men across the country joined social fraternities than in any of the last three years, growth that is especially remarkable given the changing demographics at colleges and universities. Twenty years ago, men represented 60 percent of college students. Today, they represent just 40 percent. More fraternities are doing a better job recruiting men than they ever have before.

Chi Phi is on the leading edge of this trend. The average size of our chapters has increased more than 30 percent in the last 10 years. While bigger Chapters are generally healthier Chapters, the health and impact of our Chapters depends equally on the quality and the character of the men who seek to become Brothers. This is where Chi Phi stands out. The men joining today represent our values, and they honor them. They want to become part of something bigger than themselves. They want to develop lifelong friends. They want to become leaders. They want to make an impact.

Chi Phi is filling a void in values and character based leadership education on campuses across the country. By encouraging Brothers to become the productive citizens, strong leaders, and good friends our 21st-century world needs, we have become more than a social organization.

Chi Phi is a force for good for Brothers, their campuses, and their communities, and today's Brothers are making our Brotherhood even stronger.



The Power of the Brotherhood to Unite Our Nation

OUR PAST, PRESENT, & FUTURE

We live in a fractured society, but so did past Chi Phi Brothers, and none more so than those who sought to lead the Brotherhood after the Civil War.

The unification of Chi Phi's Northern and Southern Orders in 1874—through which Chi Phi adopted the name of the Southern Order and the rituals of the Northern Order—sent a powerful message to people well beyond the Fraternity. That message still resonates today. By putting sectionalism aside and extending the hand of Brotherhood to men they faced across the battlefield, Chi Phi Brothers demonstrated that no matter our past, no matter our differences, there exist common ideals that bind us together. These Brothers understood that the only way to move forward during American Reconstruction and achieve success as a nation was to work together.

Over 150 years later, Chi Phi Chapters honor that historic moment every day. Our Brothers represent different races, religions, socioeconomic levels, political parties, opinions, and majors. At Chapters across the nation, we bring together men who might not otherwise come together, and in doing so, we create Chapters that reflect the real world around us and men with the capacity to empathize with, listen to, and lead their communities long after their time on campus has come to an end.



FUNDING OUR FUTURE

\$4 MILLION

Everything Chi Phi has is the result of our predecessors. Past Brothers gave generously of both their time and treasure so that Chi Phi would remain strong for the future.

As we look ahead, that responsibility shifts to us. What will we do to make sure future generations can benefit from all that Chi Phi has to offer?

The single most important step we can take is to strengthen the Trust's investment fund. That's because your gift will earn interest, creating a reliable revenue stream that will support the Trust for future generations of Brothers. This revenue stream will:

- Reduce our exposure to risk during periods of economic uncertainty.
- Strengthen the Trust's fiscal sustainability over the long term and reduce our dependence on annual fundraising.
- Grant us the financial flexibility to push boundaries, innovate, and continue leveraging our strengths, so that we continue to Build Better Men for decades to come.

Moreover, with an investment policy designed to minimize risk, the annual earnings we use from the investment fund will represent only a portion of the fund's growth year after year. Under our stewardship, your gift has the potential to grow and thereby contribute more to the Chi Phi Educational Trust with every passing year.



As we build our endowment, we have identified 3 strategic focus areas:







CHI PHI ISN'T FOR FOUR YEARS. IT'S FOR LIFE.

As Ric Perez, Theta Delta 1981, Trustee and Campaign Co-Chair, looks back on his more tha 45 years as a Chi Phi Brother, he sees three distinct phases.

Phase 1: Acceptance and Fun

"As an 18-year-old first-year student from Miami, rush at the University of Florida was so foreign to me. Neither of my parents had gone to university, and I certainly had never experienced an environment like UF. Finding Chi Phi created an instant place of acceptance and focus for experiencing the wonderful institution that UF can be, both socially and academically. Chi Phi was my anchor."

Phase 2: Diversity and Growth

"As I matured and got more serious about life, career, relationships, society, and academics, my experience at Chi Phi added to my personal development. It introduced me to a hugely diverse base of men that I could have never gotten to know outside of Chi Phi. After almost fifty years, it is still the most diverse organization I have ever belonged to. I learned so much about how to get along with people different than myself, how to hear out other points of view, how to defend my own views (without judgment), and how to work together for a common cause. I grew so much learning from and being mentored by older Brothers, who may have been very different, but still helped me because I was their Chi Phi Brother. Almost all the leadership experiences I achieved at UF emanated, directly or indirectly, from being a Chi Phi.



Phase 3: Principles and Belonging

"When I graduated from UF, I took with me two important attributes from Chi Phi: principles and a true sense of legacy. Chi Phi taught honesty, excellence, acceptance, and commitment. Theta Delta ingrained those into me. They are lasting truths that have followed me everywhere. I can say without hesitation that the passion I have for UF, Chi Phi, the power of diverse thought, and people was ignited at Chi Phi. As a Cuban American, nationalized U.S. citizen, and someone who has now lived in seven U.S. states and four countries, Chi Phi gave me the tools and the glue to use my cultural experiences and meld them to create a sense of belonging even in the most chaotic and complex environments. I owe a lot to Chi Phi, UF and Theta Delta. I see the upcoming Chi Phi bicentennial as a chance to magnify all the things I love about Chi Phi, and that is why I'm so excited and committed to it."



Our signature leadership programs, Alphas and Thetas Academy (ATA) and Regional Leadership Alliance (RLA), are the most effective tools the Fraternity has to achieve our mission.

These programs connect Brothers from Chapters all over the country with one another and with alumni who can help them navigate life on their campus and in their community while mentoring them so they can become leaders after they graduate.

The value of these programs lies far beyond their ability to help Brothers understand their positions and execute their duties within their Chapters. This is where Brothers develop deep friendships and find mentors. This is where they develop skills—from strategic planning and conflict resolution to risk management and resume building—that they'll use their entire lives. This is where they learn to use their voice, their positions, and the opportunities they are presented to improve the world around them.

While our programs have exploded in popularity, their content remains largely unchanged because we have not had the funding to refresh them. In a Greek system where other fraternities have modernized their flagship programs, Chi Phi is at risk of remaining in the past.



LEADERSHIP TRAINING PROGRAMS

IMPACTING BROTHERS EVERY DAY.

Alphas & Thetas Academy brings Chapter Presidents and New Member Educators together for a one-of-a-kind training experience while connecting them to Alphas and Thetas from across the country, Educational Trust leadership, Grand Council members, and alumni. Alphas and Thetas Academy equips Brothers with the skills and tools they need to lead their Chapters while navigating the unique challenges facing their communities. Brothers leave with an understanding of their roles and responsibilities, strategic plans to improve their Chapters, a support network to help them achieve success, and skills they can apply in their jobs and communities long after they graduate.

Regional Leadership Alliances

brings together Chapter officers from colleges and universities within the same region to understand the expectations, duties, and responsibilities of their Executive Council role; identify national resources that can assist them in more effectively managing their Chapter; and practice putting new skills to work. RLAs are open to every Brother, no matter how long they have been a Brother or whether they hold a leadership position.

Founding Principle Series provides carefully curated webinars that feature professionals and experts in fields ranging from finance to philanthropy. These educational webinars stem from the idea that learning is a lifelong activity that does not stop at graduation.

- **1. Revamp ATA & RLA immediately** so that they reflect and respond to the needs of today's Brothers and Chapters;
- 2. Grow our Founding Principles Series so we can provide access to a wide array of experts and resources in a variety of fields that will aid in personal and professional development for our Brothers;
- **3. Evaluate all our programs regularly** so that they continue to meet the needs of Brothers as their needs evolve; and
- 4. Develop new leadership training programs, including programs designed for each executive officer and for Brothers at large, all of whom face challenges on their campuses each day, so that we can grow our reach and expand our impact across Chapters, universities, and communities.

From the very beginning Brother Palmer Braunstein, Delta Pi 2024, noticed something different about Chi Phi.

"During rush, everyone I met was a stand-up gentleman. It was clear, even then, that Chi Phi Brothers were pushing themselves to be leaders on campus," said Palmer, who will graduate from Georgia Southwestern University in 2024.

Alphas and Thetas Academy and the Regional Leadership Alliances were vital stepping stones on Brother Braunstein's path to becoming the leader he is today. "The other Brothers at the conference, alumni, national office staff—everyone was there to extend the hand of Brotherhood, to help you grow and overcome whatever struggles your Chapter was experiencing," he explained.

For Brother Braunstein, the value of Chi Phi's leadership training programs extends far beyond the practical skills he gained. "Right away, you realize that you have this connection with everyone in the room. You see that you are part of something much bigger than yourself, that Chi Phi is bigger than one Brother or one Chapter," he explained. "Because of these programs, I realized I will always have a place to fit in no matter where I go. The bonds you make aren't just for four years. They are lifetime bonds, and these programs are life changing experiences."





SCHOLARSHIPS

Giving to Chi Phi Educational Trust's merit-based scholarship fund is one of the best investments you can make in our mission. Scholarships allow us to recognize Brothers who are achieving success in the classroom, improving their Chapters, and making an impact on their campuses and in their communities.

Scholarship recipients live and breathe our values. They believe in the Brotherhood, and they are working to make it stronger.

Scholarships are transformative for Brothers who receive them.

- They lower a student's cost to attend undergraduate and graduate programs increasingly important as tuition climbs alongside inflation.
- They reduce students' lifetime financial strain by lowering their debt obligations.
- They spark virtuous cycles, encouraging Brothers to keep striving as they graduate and take on leadership roles in towns and cities across the country.

Scholarships also enhance our Fraternity. They help us recruit and retain the best men on every campus. They send a powerful message about the value we place on developing leaders and Building Better Men. They inspire lasting loyalty and involvement with Chi Phi.

Two factors limit the impact of our scholarships today:

- 1. We have far more qualified applicants than scholarships to award. Last year, we received more than 70 percent more applications than we did just five years ago.
- 2. While any scholarship makes a difference in the lives of a Brother, our awards no longer make the impact they once did, even when our Chapters supplement our awards with their own Chapter Excellence Funds. Most of the scholarships we award are for \$1,000; our largest is \$2,700.

Through The Bicentennial Capital Campaign, we will grow our scholarship fund so that we can provide scholarships to more deserving Brothers and grow the size of our scholarship awards so that they make a more profound impact on the lives of their recipients both while they are in school and after they graduate.

With your gift to support scholarships, you will be the reason Chi Phi Brothers can focus on learning, leading, and serving on their campuses. You will be the reason our alumni can focus on seizing opportunities to lead in their careers and their communities after they graduate.



He had recently moved on campus, which dramatically increased his cost to attend Oglethorpe University, and he was preparing to apply to dental school. "Moving on campus and applying to dental school are expensive. It was a huge stress for me," said Brother Franco. "Receiving that scholarship gave me the chance to catch up so that I could focus on my classes and crossing the bridge to this next phase of my life," he explained. "I am so grateful for the Brothers who made this scholarship possible."

Brother Franco is thrilled that The Bicentennial Captial Campaign will enable Chi Phi to award scholarships to more Brothers. "These are merit scholarships. You have to earn it," he added. Digitizing Our Archives: \$200,000


As a fraternal organization, we are defined by our history, and we build on it every day.

Chi Phi Educational Trust is proud to be the steward of a remarkable archival collection dating back to the 1800s. The objects in this collection—from letters and photographs to memorabilia and audio recordings—have the potential to paint the picture of who we were, what we have been through, and how we became the resilient men's social organization we are today.

The challenge we face when it comes to the collection is one of accessibility. Because it resides in an archival storage facility, it is almost completely inaccessible to staff, researchers, and Brothers.


Through The Bicentennial Capital Campaign, we will turn our history into one of our greatest strengths. Chi Phi Educational Trust is proud to partner with HistoryIT, a firm that specializes in helping Greek organizations preserve their history and share it with their Brotherhoods and Sisterhoods. HistoryIT has already completed an assessment of the entire collection. Together, we have developed a comprehensive plan to preserve pieces in need of repair, digitize the collection, and make the entire collection—with the exception of objects tied to rituals—accessible through an online museum.





THE CHI PHILE

175TH ANNIVERSARY



With your gift to The Bicentennial Capital Campaign, you have the opportunity to help us complete the first phase of this seven-phase project, which focuses on digitizing objects that are most at risk of further, irreparable deterioration, including:

- 1. Documents, books, and manuscript material from Chi Phi's earliest days—most of which date to the 19th century.
- 2. A collection of 14 scrapbooks and albums that tell the stories of Chi Phi Brothers through photographs, clippings, event programs, and correspondence. Most are in poor condition and suffer from weak bindings, missing spines, loose pages, and detached photos.
- 3. Audio and video recordings that provide a unique window into the lives of Brothers past, including VHS and audio cassettes and other now obsolete media formats, which have reached the peak of their expected lifespan and are beginning to degrade rapidly.

Digitizing our collection will not only preserve the objects themselves; it will also preserve their ability to tell stories in perpetuity and ensure their storytelling potential isn't limited to people who can travel to and experience our collection in person.

With your gift to support the first phase of this project, you will help us uncover stories that have been kept behind locked doors for far too long. In doing so, you will ensure that future Brothers understand Chi Phi's history in the greater context of American and world history. You will create new opportunities for future Brothers to engage with one another, their Chapters, and the national fraternity. You will strengthen the ties that bind Brothers across time and place.


